

# Fraser came up with this design for Greenbelt Seminar Floor Chairs:



1. Put the box on one end, so that the open side is pointing away from you.

2. In the photo my hand is in front of the bottom of the box.

3. Cut along the edge of the box as shown to just above the halfway point of the box. Do this on both sides.

4. Fold the side flaps back, but keep the bottom flap out along the ground

5. Then push down on the top surface of the box (the top as it appears in the photo) so that the top is pushed right down to the ground - this is where your bum goes.

6. You may need to reinforce the back of the chair with parcel tape or similar. Not shown.

If you use your box to bring supplies to Greenbelt you may want to prepare it by putting in the cuts and resealing them with parcel tape AND do your reinforcement of the back before you go to Greenbelt

5. Push down the top until it hits the bottom
