

## STREETSPACE Impact Report 2013/4 www.streetspace.org.uk

The StreetSpace community has continued to grow over the last year. Almost three quarters (74%) of projects undertook additional training in the last year, and 92% are engaging with the Community of Practice. The community is very active on our Facebook group and we held our fourth annual gathering in March, which was well attended.

The StreetSpace team meet with each project at least three times a year and assist in completing a Processes and Outcomes review which helps to analyse the amount and quality of contact that project is having with Young People.

## COMMUNITY FEEDBACK

**100%** of StreetSpace projects say that being part of StreetSpace has helped them reflect on their practice, do more creative work and improved the impact they have on young people.

**85%** say that their membership has helped them to help young people have an impact on their community.

**77%** say that their work with young people at risk has increased due to StreetSpace and that they have been able to reduce anti-social behaviour.


